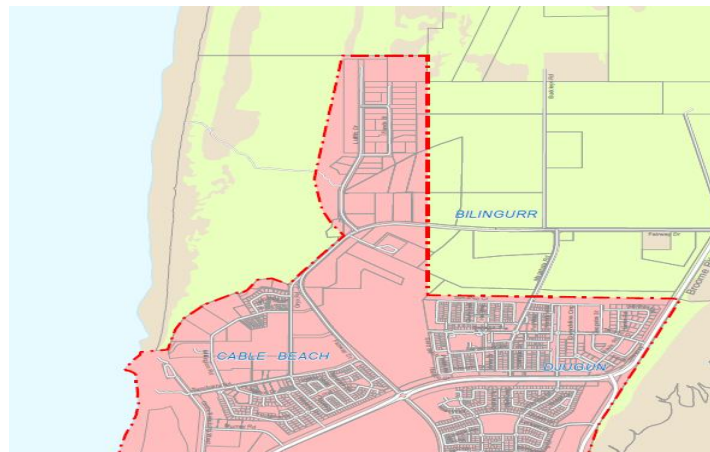

## CHANGES TO SCHOOL BUS SERVICES

The Public Transport Authority recently conducted a review of the Broome Public Transport Area. As a result, the Broome Public Transport Area has been expanded to include the Bilingurr area.

From Term 4 2020, the Bilingurr area will be serviced by TransBroome services. TransBroome is a branch of the Public Transport Authority and is responsible for the management of public transport bus services in major regional centres.

From Term 4 2020, all students residing within the area shown in pink on the map below will no longer be able to access an 'Orange' school bus.



Students using the TransBroome services will need to pay a fare and in order to take advantage of the discounted 70 cent fare, students will need to purchase a Multirider. Multiriders are produced in a booklet of ten tickets and are available from the bus driver at a purchase cost of seven dollars. Alternatively, a single cash ticket can also be purchased from the driver at a cost of \$1.40.

The new services will operate at times similar to the current orange school bus service including the pickup locations. Timetable and route information about the new services will be available from the TransRegional website.
