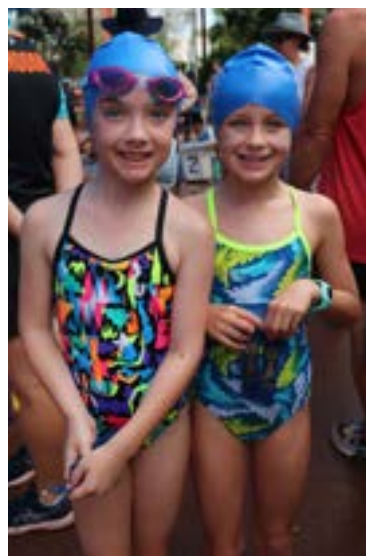

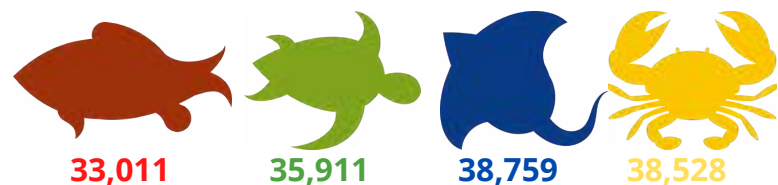

Pizza with the Principal

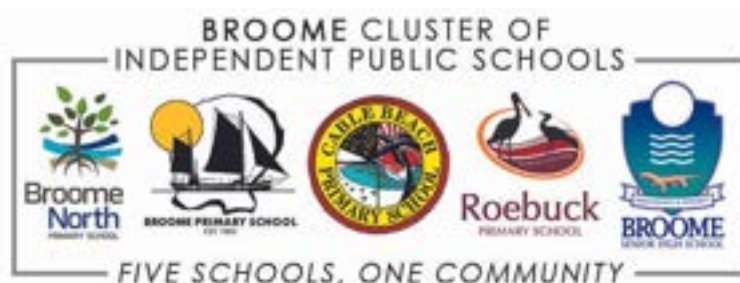
