

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Broome North Primary School Finance Committee and School Board have endorsed the following schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2026. The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$60.00 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the curriculum learning areas. While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments. Voluntary contributions collected are directed to the following areas:

- Printing or copying of text materials for use in the educational program e.g. photocopy materials.
- Printed and electronic materials which are related to the educational program and are provided for the student to borrow or keep e.g. textbooks
- Sporting and musical equipment
- Classroom resource materials e.g. art materials, computer resources, etc.
- Library Books, Reading Books, Maths Equipment.
- Craft (Kindergarten and Pre-Primary Students)
