

KISS AND GO ZONES

Understanding the rules

Kiss and Go Zones are for your child's safety and your convenience. It minimises congestion and risk when used correctly and is designed for quick entry and exit.

RULES

- 'Kiss and Go' and 'No Parking' zones operate under the same conditions.
- Drivers may stop in this Zone to drop off or pick up passengers or goods for a maximum of two minutes.
- The driver **MUST** always remain in or within three metres of the vehicle.
- The vehicle must not be left unattended.
- If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction only applies during the times shown.
- Penalties apply for illegal parking in School Zones.



REMEMBER

1. **DRIVERS DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE** - To assist with traffic flow in the Kiss and Go Zone; drivers are encouraged to remain in the car while the children get in and out. To facilitate this, children should travel with bags in the car and not in the boot.
2. **BE TIMELY** - If your child does not enter or exit the vehicle within 2 minutes, you are required to travel around the block and re-enter the Zone at the end of the queue. (Insert Street names relevant to your school)
3. **KERB SIDE ENTRY / EXIT** - Ensure your child enters/exits the vehicle on the kerb side. Ensure your child has their restraint securely fastened before moving off from the Kiss and Go Zone.
4. **STAY IN SEQUENCE** - Please queue in an orderly manner. Drop/pick up your child as close as possible to the top of the Zone, allowing vehicles following you to enter the designated area. Do not cut in the queue. If unable to get into the park, or your child is not ready, please lap around the roundabouts and return.
5. **NO U-TURNS** - Do not make U-turns in busy school zones. It is dangerous and puts children at risk. Fines and demerits may apply.

Kiss & Go Zones need cooperation to ensure the safety of all children.
